

To visit the United Nations Treaty Section Web Site, Open the Web Browser on your Computer and type in the following web address as shown below

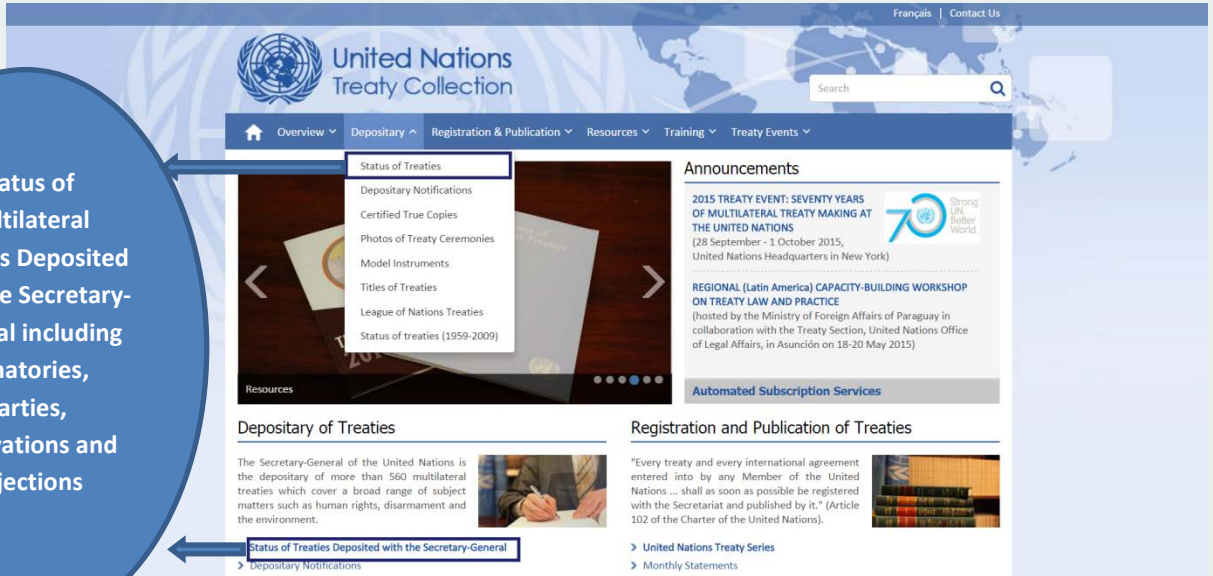

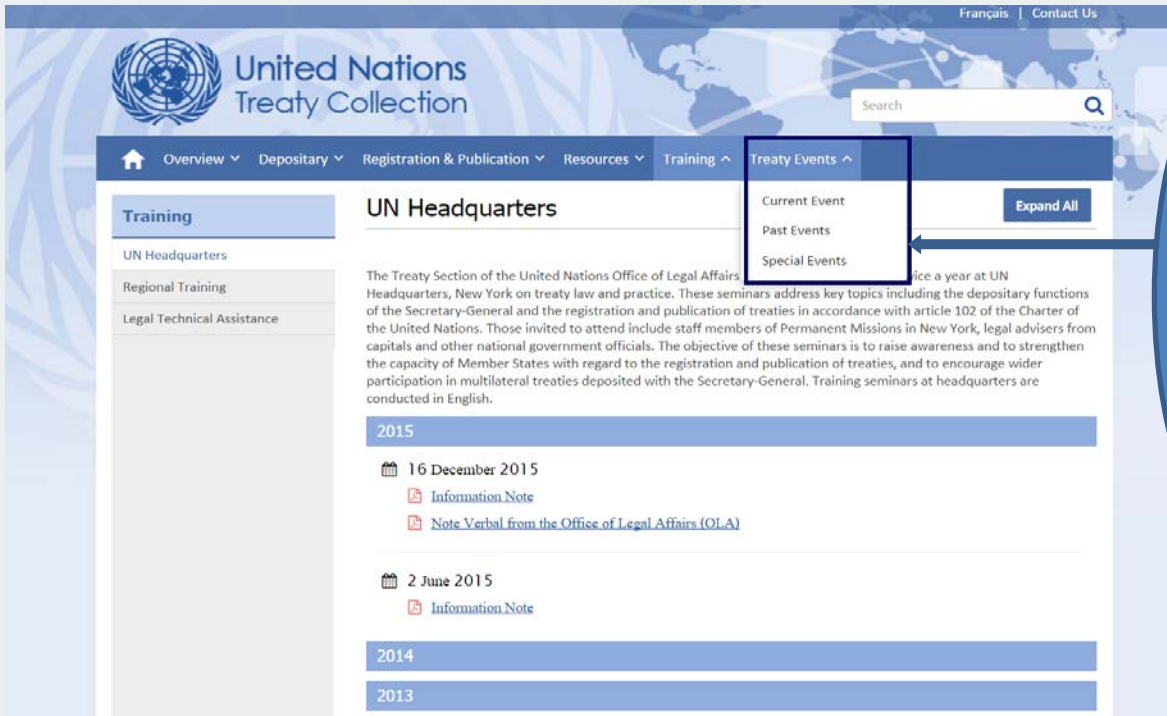
